



Dear Residents:

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic and the resulting stay at home orders which prohibits large gatherings and for the safety of our residents, the following amendment was adopted by the De Anza Santa Cruz HOA.

On Thursday January 28, 2021, The De Anza Mobile Home Park, HOA Board of Officers and Directors herein referred to as the HOA Board, adopted the following Bylaw (see below). The new Bylaw extends the terms of office for Officers and Directors for one year and postpones elections for HOA Board Officers and Directors one year.

AMENDMENTS TO THE DE ANZA SANTA CRUZ HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.'S FIRST AMENDED BYLAWS:

The Bylaws of the De Anza Santa Cruz Homeowners Association First Amended Bylaws shall be amended as follows:

1. The following shall be added to Section 4.2. All provisions relating to nominations and voting of Officers and Directors shall be postponed for a period of one year. The present Officers and Directors shall remain in office until July 2022. Nominations and voting for Officers and Directors in 2022 shall be for all of the Officers and Directors of the Association. Thereafter, the offices of the Officers and Directors whose terms would have expired in 2021, shall have the new Officers and Directors terms voted in 2022 expire in 2023. The Officers and Directors who take office in 2022 whose terms would have expired in 2022 will have their terms expire in 2024. This amendment is passed as an emergency measure due to COVID-19 concerns.
